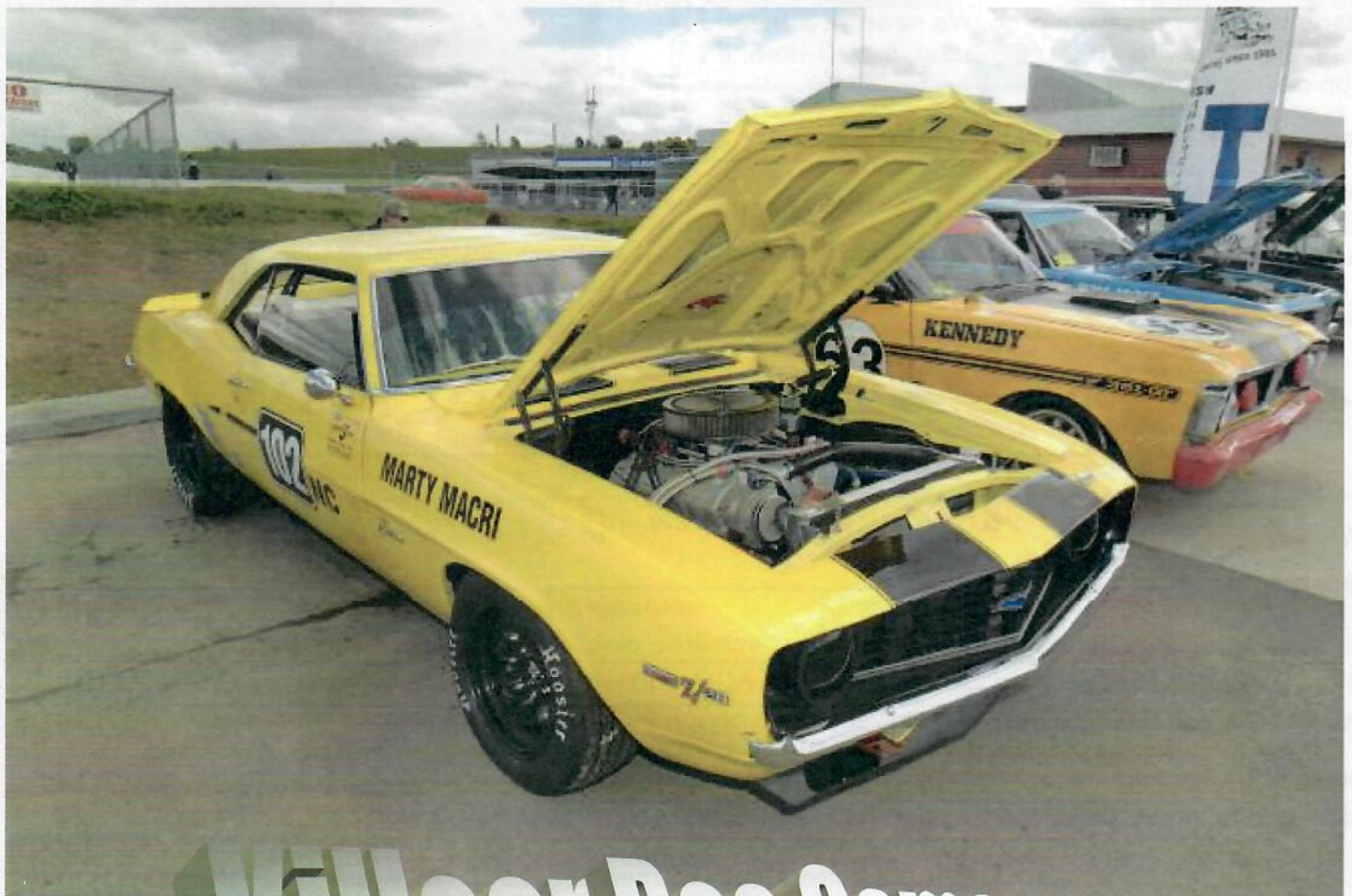

President's Report: D. Roberts advised the meeting that FoSC will not be at Eastern Creek at Easter next year. It is more likely they will take a date in August instead to run a 2 + 4-type event.

James O'Brien [Yeegah] will be running at Bathurst at Easter. Members can enter by contacting W. Bossie. The entry fee is \$1,000 + GST and fuel cannot be taken to the event; members must buy their fuel from Yeegah's fuel provider.

Mallala will run Historics at Easter D. Roberts advised he has asked Mallala for a flyer for the magazine.

CAMS have sent a financial report and advise that they have a new Historics staff member, Keith Simpson.

The Historic Commission has made formal application to the Queensland Historic Touring Association to allow banners on the windscreen of entries for the Black Truck Series. They may then review to see if it will work in NSW.

Group Nc Rotary engine sealing rules have been modified and are available to view on the CAMS website

D. Roberts suggested to the meeting that more officials are needed for events, mostly flaggies. Members who have flagged can download a form from the CAMS website and have an official sign the form, at a meeting, do an online module and gain a General Official's licence.

We have 20 entrants for the HSRCA event at Wakefield in September.

The Shed has been completed. It now has a run-up area constructed from 7.5t of road base. It has electricity and a trestle table. You will need to sign for the key for The Shed at the Wakefield Office.

The Astor Carnival on 15th July provided heaps of racing with only 4 categories. Six Group N cars attended.

We are down on number for the Muscle Car Masters with 24 Nb and 24 Nc; we need more entries. If there aren't enough for 2 grids, some entries may be "bumped".

A Development Application has been lodged for the proposed track at Ringwood. Dungog are awaiting the outcome of this DA before they go ahead.

D. Roberts advised that Ian Pope, an HSRCA club member, had passed away earlier this month.

General Meeting (cont'd)

Secretary's Report: The next pointscore meeting is Muscle Car Masters. If you lodge an entry in by 19th August the fee is \$360. Entries close on 26th August, but after 19th entry fee goes up by \$100.

The HSRCA has released race dates for 2012. They will run a 3-day Tasman Series at the end of 2012

The Astor Round is very much worth supporting. It was a good day and members receive value for money.

T. Thompson gave an overview of the new track extension at ECIR. It will open for business on 2nd August. He stated that 5 tenders have been received for the extension at the back of Corporate Hill. They are all under budget. And there is some good news about a Museum being constructed at ECIR.

T. Thompson also spoke of the anniversaries at the SECC. The Volvo Clubs has invited Irv Gordon to the event. Irv is the owner of a P1800, which has travelled almost 3 million miles.

C. Dubois had a question regarding the ARDC application form. T. Thompson advised that he will sort it out as soon as possible. Lynn Brown will be driving an XK at MCM

D. Roberts thanked C. Dubois for bringing the "lost" stickers to the meeting.

B. Smith noted that the website is in need of updating. D. Roberts advised that it is underway.
