September General Meeting Minutes

Minutes General Meeting 10th September 2013

The meeting commenced at: **8:00 pm.**

Attendance: As per Attendance Book.

Apologies: D. Roberts, C. Gabriel, A. Mayne

New Members: Nil

May Minutes: As published in *Action-Line*

Matters Arising: Addressed in General Business.

President's Report: **M. Ducquet**

MD gave a report on MCM:

- It was a good event. Well run. Feedback from all competitors and organisers was very positive. There were a few complaints about competitors regarding window banners. He thanked all those members who assisted.
- Presentation on the Saturday night of MCM was also a great event with 342 people attending.
- All competitors in EH Only race received a plaque. MD thanked Phil & Marilyn Taylor for sponsoring the trophies for the event.
- MD stated that Ray Berghouse, of Chevron Publishing will give good coverage of this year's event and is keen to support the event in the future. RB suggested that the event be called the "Group N Nationals" at future MCM events. CAMS will be consulted in this regard.
- MD stated \$1,645 dollars of raffle tickets and merchandise was sold at MCM. He suggested a merchandise stand be set up in a busier area next year. He spoke about the merchandise which was on offer at the event.
- MD thanked I. Johnson for his assistance in storing the trailer and merchandise.
- T. Ducquet has organised a new website domain provider for \$55 per year, rather than \$66 per month.

Secretary's Report: **J. Williams**

- The AGM is due on Tuesday 8th October. Forms are in the magazine and the website.
- 168 financial members.
- Raffle ticket returns still slow.
- 72 emails in and 68 out, the bulk of which were MCM related.
- JW please asked the members that due to the costs of printing and mailing the magazine taking up to half of membership funds, that members to consider taking an E-copy to help offset costs.

Treasurer's Report: **C, Gabriel (Absent)**

HSRCA Report - D. Roberts (Absent)

AHTCA - M. Ducquet

- MD stated that the Historic Commission asked for a vote on limiting negative camber to 4 degrees. HTCS NSW voted for 5 degrees if necessary, but unanimously agreed that we prefer to leave the rules regarding this issue as they are.

CAMS / CMC / ARDC - T. Thompson

CAMS.

- There was a meeting on 16th August.
- NSW Branch has only one staffer now.
- He stated that the new MD for CAMS appears to be having a positive effect and has advised staff they must attend 15 weekend race meetings per year, or resign. 16 staff members have left CAMS as a result. The new CEO is very supportive of promising young drivers and will support them with dollars to enable them to get the proper training and experience.

CMC

- 50th Anniversary luncheon coming up. Four of the original committee members have been found and will attend. No new clubs to vote in. \$25,000 raised for Prostate Cancer Council Research,

ARDC.

- TT gave a run down of ARDC events coming up in 2014.
- Tasman Revival in 2014 will be run by the ARDC instead of HSRCA, which would indicate a more favourable outlook for Group N. No indication as to entry fees for 2014, as yet.

Eligibility - W. Rogerson

- V. Macri spoke of MCM with D. Twigg "doing the rounds". General feedback from competitors was good.
- Nothing much happening with new car business. Issues regarding Mazda ongoing.
- He stated that there is an issue with roll cages. He advised members to keep abreast of CAMS updates in this regard. Especially where a new build is in progress.

General Business:

- W. Rogerson thanked MD for his efforts with regard to the MCM event.
- MD stated that he will soon be involved in discussions with R. Berghouse regarding 2014 MCM. It will be the 50th Anniversary of the Cooper 'S' and 1964 Mustang. He is proposing a Cooper 'S' only race and a combined NB /Nc Mustang only race. He expects this will bring in more of these competitors next year. There will be no Grid Spectacular next year. R. Berghouse will promote the Cooper 'S' and Mustang race to the ARDC.

September General Meeting

Minutes (cont'd)

- M. D. praised the efforts of various entrants for preparation of their vehicles, and in particular, B. Potts for his consistency in preparation of his Monaro over the years and having deserved his recent award in this regard.
- MD praised all HTCA members at MCM for their efforts on the day.
- MD read a letter to the meeting from P. Truelove with regard to his concerns with breakdown and distribution of entry fees for the BMF. MD responded to P. Truelove that this has nothing to do with the HTCA. He needs to discuss the issue with T. Williams or D. Roberts, who are involved in promoting the event.
- R. Muller spoke of his submission for a substitution engine block. He stated that he had completed the research process, but was told he had used the incorrect form when making his submission. He stated he was disappointed at the lack of feedback and action regarding his submission. He criticised the process involved and suggested changes need to be made in this regard.
- MD reiterated the process for submissions as it stands now with all club members (nationally) asked to vote on submission before they are sent to CAMS. i.e. AHTCA to act as a "firewall" for submission. He stated that only a small percentage of members in NSW actually voted.
- R. Muller moved that the club receives clarification that the AHTCA & CAMS will follow procedures as laid down. MD to follow up on this issue, especially with regard to the rotary engine and substitution block submissions.
- R. Muller spoke of issues with Security Guards at MCM. T. Thompson advised that these issues had been noted and the issues would be dealt with. A lengthy discussion ensued around this issue.
- B. Jessup spoke of a new race track being built on the Central Coast. CASAR Park. MD read out correspondence outlining details of the venue etc.
- J. Williams tabled a petition from the Motorlife Museum to go the Federal Govt regarding changes to the Moveable Cultural Heritage Act. T. Thompson explained the reasons for the petition being raised.
- A discussion ensued about how in some cases local public complaints about noise have been instrumental in closing some local motor racing venues and has stopped further development in this regard in NSW.

- MD appraised the members about arrangements for the annual Presentation Dinner on 2nd November. The price this year will be \$80 per head and will include beer, wine and soft drinks. The room has been booked. Some interstate members are coming up for the dinner. The Guest of Honour to be announced at a later date. There is a form on the website and in the magazine.
- L. Kennedy asked that people advise early who they wish to sit with at the Presentation Dinner to avoid issues on the night.
- L. Kennedy asked if the club will be running over and under 3500cc for Group Nc at MCM in 2014. MD stated that it will be run. He went on to explain statistics in this regard at MCM this year.

1. Outright results count as 6+ starters (1st, 2nd, 3rd)
2. Points are divided by the number of scratch races held at each meeting.
3. 3 Points are allocated for entering and participating in a meeting
4. 1 bonus point is allocated for the fastest lap in each class over the entire meeting.
5. Members flagging at a pointscore round are allocated 10 points per day, subject to a maximum of 30 points

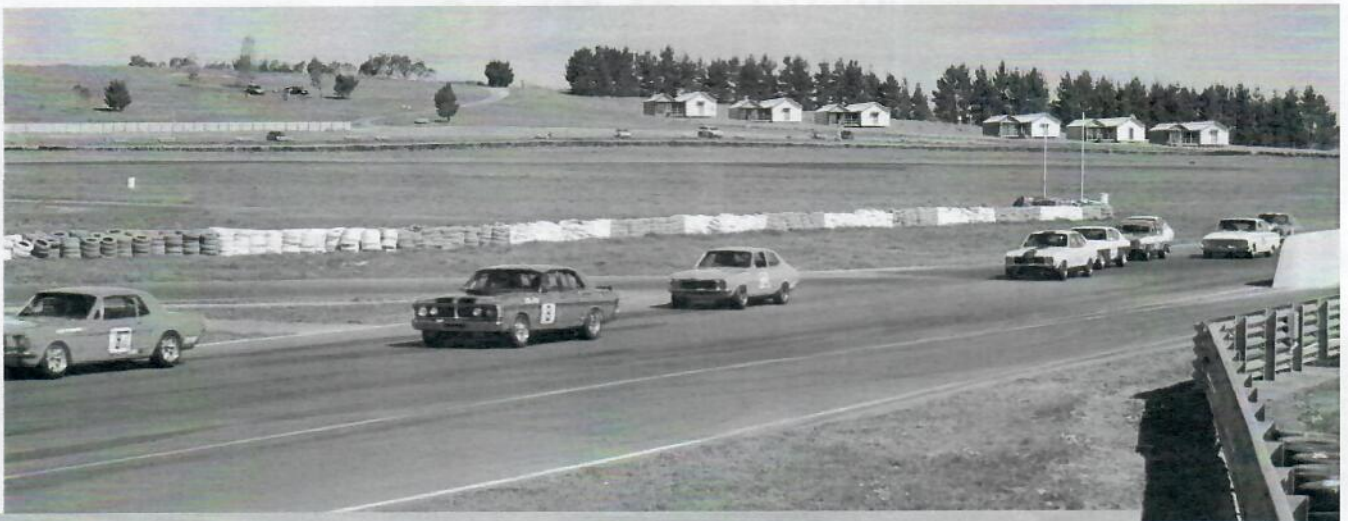

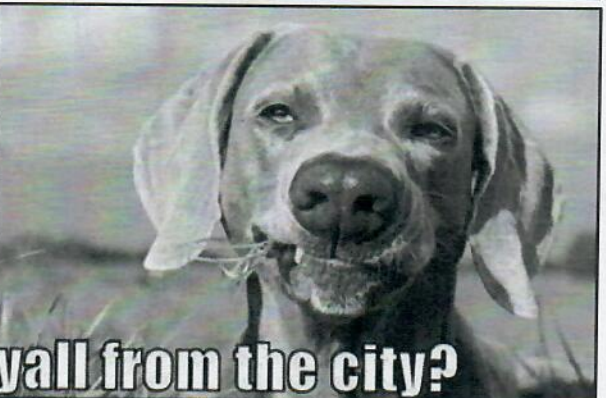
God continued pointing to different countries. "This one will be extremely hot, while this one will be very cold and covered in ice."

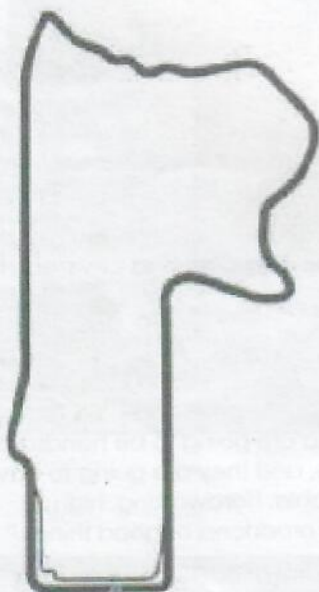

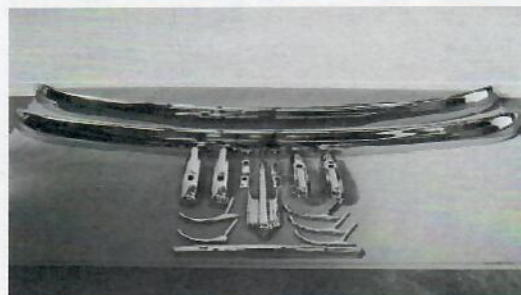
