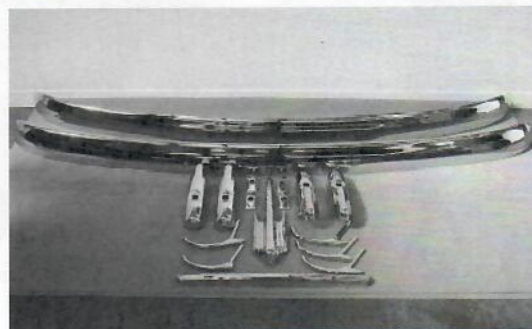

**Treasurer's Report:** End of financial year figures will be ready for publication in the November magazine.

**Competition Report:**

FoSC at Wakefield in November has been cancelled due to lack of interest.

There is a one-day meeting at ECIR on Saturday 10th December. Email sent out today. D. Roberts has received 15 entries to date.

**AHTCA:**

Some email discussion has taken place around driving standards. The rules are somewhat ambiguous and needs more manpower to police it in order to make it work.

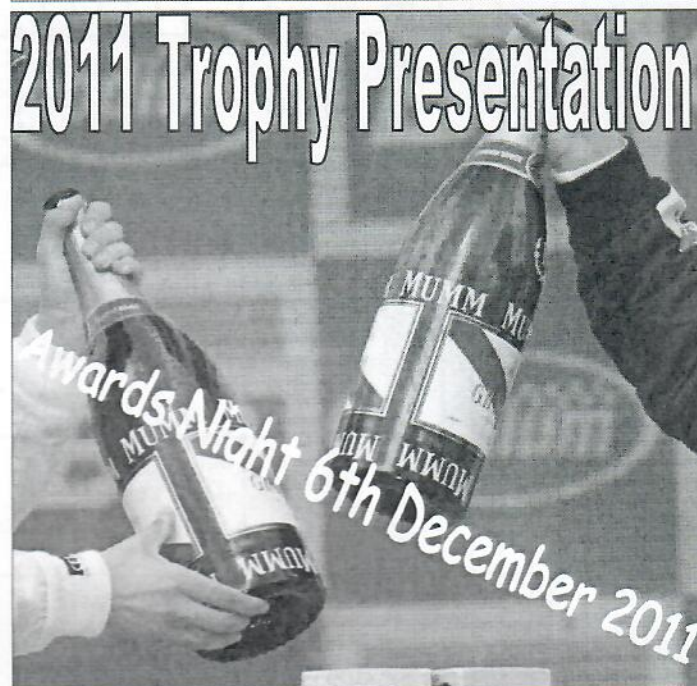

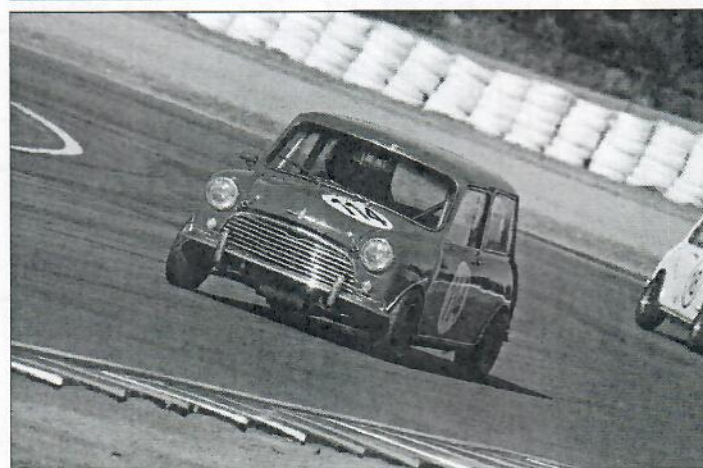

# Westwood Named Rare Spares Hard Charger at 'The Mountain'.

New South Welshman Doug Westwood has been named the Bathurst 1000 Rare Spares Hard Charger award winner for round five of the 2011 Touring Car Masters (presented by Autobarn).

Having debuted his #62 Falcon Fire Protection 1971 Ford Falcon XY GTHO at the series' opening round, the Clipsal 500 Adelaide in 2010, Westwood finally moved from his Group N to a full TCM spec engine for last month's Muscle Car Masters event where he achieved top ten results in each race, coming home seventh for the weekend.

Arriving at the mountain circuit, Westwood and the team knew they could achieve again but struggled in the opening practice session placing 24th but knew there was much more to offer from the car. Heading into qualifying, Westwood and the Falcon Fire Protection team had worked hard to gain more stability in the GTHO and increase Westwood's confidence across the top of the mighty mountain. Unable to gain a clear run, Westwood put the XY on 21st with a lot of fighting for position gain ahead.

Race 1 of the weekend would see Westwood start alongside the Porsche of Nelson, with the Holdens of O'Brien and Alexander set in his sights. Westwood spent the laps in an outstanding battle to charge through the pack, taking seven positions to cross the line for the final lap in 14th, before the throttle cable broke on the restart, sending him to the DNF list.

The Falcon Fire Protection team had until the afternoon to have the GTHO ready to roar once again, now well prepared to challenge from a rear of grid start in race two. From 29th, Westwood launched off the line putting in an outstanding effort to move into 20th by the close of the first lap. Up to 16th by lap two, it was then a battle with the HQ GTS of O'Brien, HQ of Kassulke and HT Monaro of Alexander that saw the mighty Ford press on to come home on the verge of the top ten, 11th place an outstanding achievement.

The final race start on aggregate points put Westwood back to 16th, but the race started with the same charging spirit as he shot wide along the main straight looking to gain an early position. Challenging Matt O'Brien and Alexander, Westwood was driving hard, pulling out a five second buffer as he tried to hunt down the fellow GTHO of Karanfilovski ahead. Completing the shortened race in 11th, Westwood had driven hard pushing the GTHO for all it had across the mountain, taking another four positions to have made a gain of 17 places across the event.

*Doug Westwood:*

"Feels great to have this achievement, but it's with mixed emotions as we're hoping Andrew is ok as he's been next to us all weekend and a great mate so thoughts are with him.

"It was a hard and challenging weekend with such a little issue of the broken throttle cable putting us out after a great fight through in the first race so that was disappointing but we battled through.

"I've got a great team with Michael, John, Wes and my father all helping out so we've sorted the car, got a bit more horsepower and with the engine from Ned Sassine at Hercules, that has made a big difference this weekend being able to use the power.

"We had an issue with the gearbox in the last race, but still had a good run so I'm very happy and we can only move forward from here."

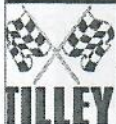
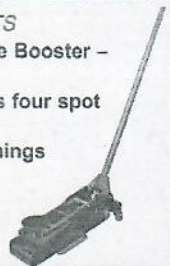

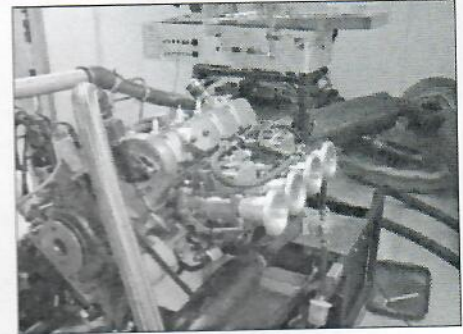
