HSRCA Wakefield Park 20-21st February

This meeting, changed from a Family Day/No Frills, to a full 2 day meeting attracted only 140 entries. Group N provided 30 [2 Na, 15Nb, 12Nc + 1 Invited HQ Holden]

Our whole Group ran in qualifying. Wayne Seabrook in his new Porsche was fastest followed by Jason Foley [GT Falcon] and Bob Cox [Mustang]. Max Ullrich [Mustang] was fastest in Nb.

Whilst entries were low it was pleasing to see some new members racing and also some returning from long absences.

New to our category John Wright and Paul Cameron [Toranas]

Graham Russell [Nc Mini] returned to the track after many years and was by far the quickest Mini.

Wayne Rogerson brought out the rebuilt Mazda RX2 and was immediately on the pace.

Dave Probin reappeared in the repaired Austin A35 however was forced to retire on Saturday afternoon with engine bearing rattles.

Ivan Glasby made a rare appearance in his Mini.

An Escort 1300GT, recently purchased from Victoria ran in Regularity. The owner advises he is planning to race in our category this year.

I was only at WP on Saturday and can report that our group had plenty of laps for the entry dollar.

Due to the low entry the program was ahead of schedule. This resulted in some of our cars being late to the dummy grid for their first race. As is standard policy at these meetings you cannot move up the grid.

One of our members who had practiced well started from the rear. In his attempts to improve his position he had no fewer than 5 "offs" the last one being into the flag point at the start of the back straight. This resulted in a Red Flag and the race being terminated after 5 laps. The driver ended up in hospital with suspected broken ribs, his car is probably a write off. The Flag Marshalls fortunately suffered no injuries.

Wayne Seabrook's immaculate Porsche suffered electrical problems and after starting from pole failed to finish in any of the races.

The Hillman Imp fraternity will be left scratching their heads after Jerry Lenstra posted a number of laps in the 1.14's.

As seems to be the norm our numbers dwindled as the weekend progressed. According to Natsoft we

had 14 finishers in the last race on Sunday.

The next HSRCA meeting is at Eastern Creek on 1-2 May. We need good entries to ensure we have separate fields for Nb and Nc.
