POINTSCORES

Just an update on what was in the April Action Line. If there is more than two races over a weekend we sometimes run a pointscore over all the races. Handicap races do not count at all and if a pointscore is not run we pick the two longest races including the trophy race, ie a 10 lap and 12 lap races but not an 8 lap race.

Historic race meetings interstate

When an historic meeting is held interstate on the same weekend as a pointscore meeting in Sydney, the driver who enters the Historic interstate meeting will get points in the club championship for entering that meeting because we are an Historic racing category. Points are awarded on their position in the race.






