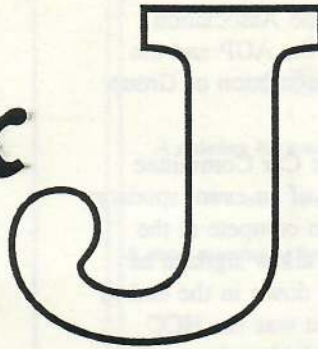

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

It is with regret that I must announce that our Adelaide involvement has been cancelled. This is as a direct result of the decision by the HCC to refuse permission to allow a race supporter's name to appear on competitors windscreens. Without this form of advertising, the sponsor refused to supply the required funds.

The sponsors were then offered the opportunity to transfer the Meeke negotiated sponsorship to the Porsche races and they have taken up this offer.

These decisions potentially rule out Group N involvement in either of the two remaining Adelaide AGP's so we will have to wait til '96 for the move to Melbourne.

As extremely disappointing as these decisions are, we must not dwell on them and should continue to look forward to ensuring a future for Group N.

I wish to publicly thank our own Tom Amos, Vic's Bob Cracknell, and WA's Bill Meeke for all their efforts in negotiations with the AGP.

Thinking positively, we can now concentrate on making Bathurst in October our premier event. Entries from interstate are running hot, so get yours in quickly to ensure your spot, as a full grid is now looking to be a certainty. I must also thank Barry Jupp from Vic for his generous support of Bathurst.

Also cancelled is the Amaroo AMSCAR on the 21st of August - due to lack of entries across all classes.

Again the alternative is the Oran Park Grand Prix event on the 14th of August. Even though we have been promoting this event as having a special long distance race, there will be the usual preliminary events, counting towards the pointscore. Entries have closed but late entries should be accepted up till about the 5th August.

Please note the date for our presentation night will be October 29. This year we are having a harbour cruise. More details are available from Ann Bailey.

In this magazine you will find a nomination form for anyone interested in working on the committee for 94-95. Please consider getting involved, as a few members have indicated they will be standing down due to work commitments.


