I would like to thank the members of the Association for their good wishes on the birth of our second son, Robert. The gift presented at the June meeting was a lovely surprise. Thank you.



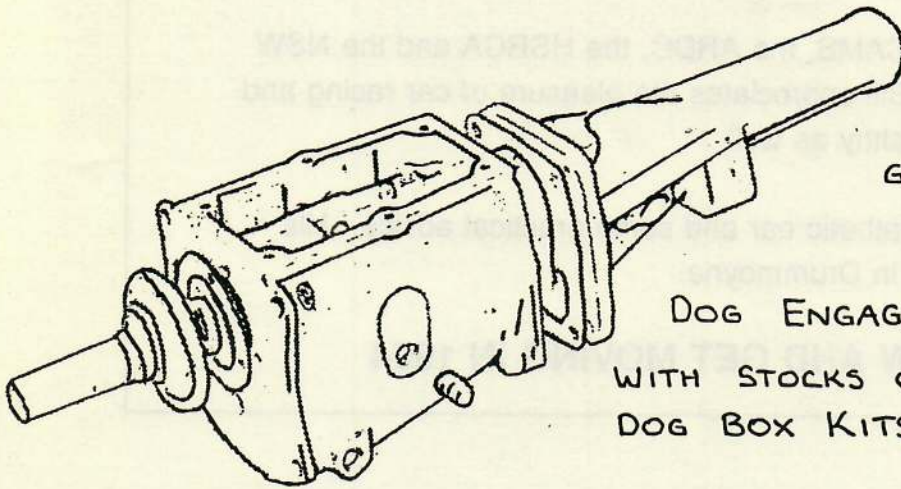
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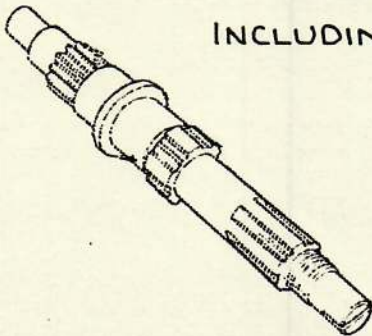
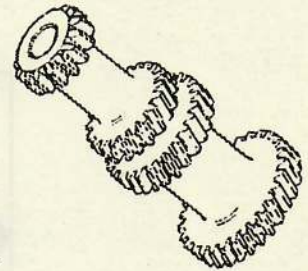
