**EDITORIAL etc.**

The event calendar for 1993 is now all but fixed and the quality of event venues should please all but the most discerning drivers. We have, in addition to the regular calendar, a number of invited events including Bathurst at Easter, Phillip Island and Lakeside Historics and possibly Adelaide GP.

All the events have been chosen at regular intervals in order to maximise the entry lists, but following both a poor grid for the Amaroo Open and only a mediocre turn out for Bathurst at Easter I am beginning to wonder if all the effort is worthwhile and we should, in fact, further reduce the number of events possible to get the grid sizes up. If you compare Appendix J to group A we have almost 50% more invited events over a longer season that extends almost over the whole year ... the events load is very great. I would be interested in any club member views on the frequency of events. It should be remembered that we have already reduced the number by about 30% from only a few years ago.

Speaking of changes, the club has embarked upon, once again, the quest for Adelaide. We are initially working with both the WA and Victorian clubs at putting together a joint submission on behalf of all the Associations for an invitation to the Adelaide GP support calendar this year. So far a draft proposal has been developed and a commitment for some funds put in place. Soon a presentation and hopefully some success. I would hope to also include the Queensland club once more details are known.

Remember the first round of the Tristate series commences in early March at Phillip Island and with Arai Helmets as the series sponsor it looks as though the series will be as popular as the one ran last year. There are currently around 10 NSW entrants travelling south for the meeting and we would hope that at least the same come from other states when the rounds move on to other venues. A great series with good prizes and a great sponsor for 1993. Need I say more?

Thanks to **INTERCITY BUSINESS CENTRE** and Robert Tweedie for their support and trophies for the Amaroo Park meeting on 28 February.

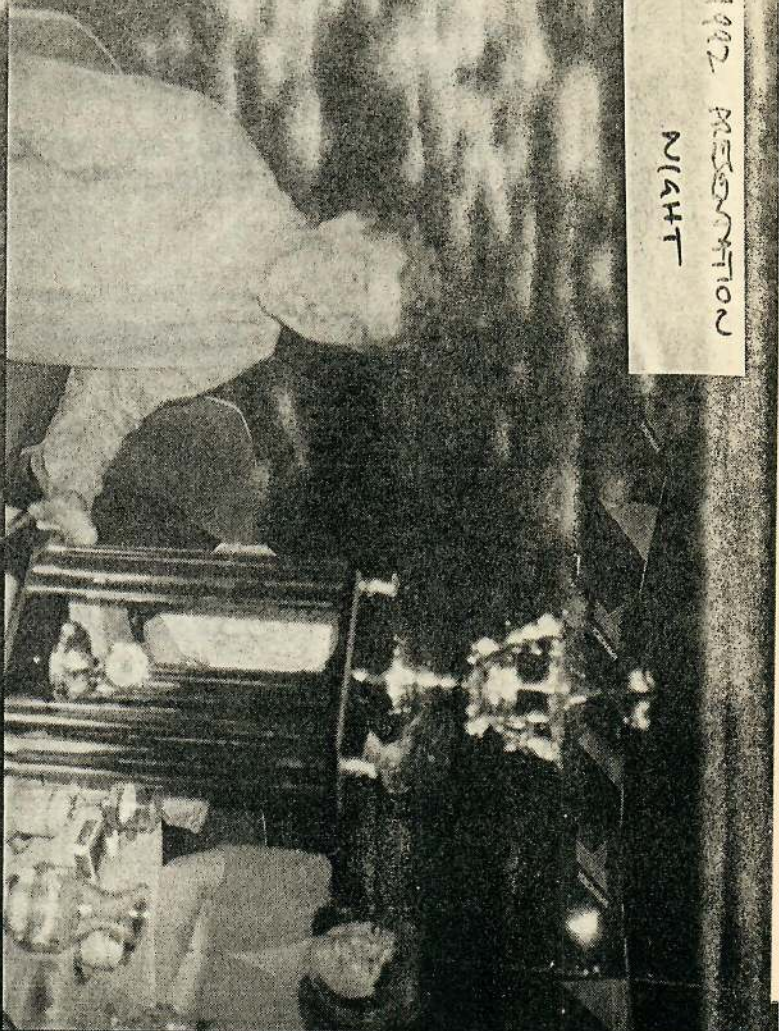
