It is also unacceptable that this founding Association is not even consulted on its' views of the current rules by a group of non participants who claim to represent our interests.

The Association has already had two votes about the new category and rejected it out of hand on the information so far. As to changing the basis of the category to "cars raced" that would be not only a major step but outside all the original concepts when the category was reintroduced.

We will just wait and see but no doubt someone may ask us what we think so if you have a view let me know!


