# **EDITORIAL**

During the month the Association positively progressed towards having a greater say in the way Group N will be administered in the future with meetings and discussions with most of the stakeholders. It is clear that the current situation of an unelected group deciding the future of Group N will change as CAMS moves towards a new structure that reflects the requirements of the 1990's.

There will always be those who never want to progress, frightened of change or wanting to retain special personal benefits that are only possible when there is no representation of the general Group N competitor views or aspirations. The scene is now set and over the next few months I would hope that a sensible relationship can evolve that benefits all.

One of the benefits of a unified Group N could be common national eligibility criteria. Last year for the Adelaide GP the combined Associations set standards for the race and policed it across Australia. Less than twelve months later even with the same desires we are heading back to the "good old days". HCC mates making arrangements on eligibility that bypass the systems in place. Calculated destructive rumour commonplace. We do not need to regress nor do we need any of the old baggage. We need a common set of rules and interpretation by the Associations. The introduction of the 1965 to 72 group will make this even more important in 1995 and the HTCC offers the most promise of success.

After several years of editing the magazine with some luck I may be able to coax someone else to have a turn ... we all live in hope. I would like to thank Julie for all the help over the years and wish whoever takes over that they actually do get some help from all those who enjoy the criticism.

General Business:


Tom asked for expressions of interest in a National Historic Touring Car Championship.
