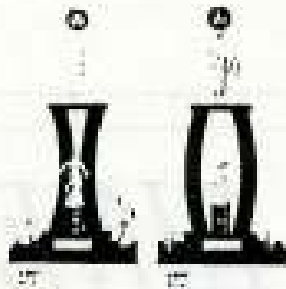

Looking out into next year there are a number of events both social and sporting that the Association is aiming at attending. Some will require some prequalification so the Association has a clear commitment and understanding of the numbers and the base cost of attending so there is included in this magazine a pre registration and deposit form for those who wish to attend the major race meetings during the year. This will allow the club as a whole to plan and deliver the quality events that Appendix J deserves in advance for the complete season. To that end the Competitions Manager, Rob Ingram and I have visited the major promoters and sought dates and undertakings to construct a calendar which provides quality racing at metered intervals.

Any deposit money sought from potential competitors would be put towards the entry fee for the event along with any sponsorship dollars the club receives so all the benefits flow to the competitor. It all looks promising and so far we have a calendar that is both varied and well spaced to suit those who do not want to race every weekend.

Moving onto tyres, that good old subject that always gets a few tempers up the general meeting passed a motion that the tyre trial was a success and the Association should now move to insert the use of tyres in the supplementary regulations of selected events. The first event chosen was the Historic in January and the club has now negotiated with the HSRCA for an amendment to that effect. This was circulated to all competitors at the Oran Park day night and will be issued in due course by the promoters as additional supp regs for the event. If this event is a success then the supp regs for other chosen events will also be amended to reflect the Association's desire to move towards a more appropriate tyre arrangement in keeping with the original aims and charter of the Association.

For the tyre changes to work, those who voted for them should enter the first event at Amaroo as a poor field will do little for both the Association and those who unanimously sought an exclusive round.

After meetings with the ARDC, Eastern Creek and the H we are able to put together a racing calendar with fairly firm dates. Not all of the meetings will host Appendix J races, but we are able to choose several meetings from the range that each Promoter has organised.

The message that comes over loud and clear from the Promoters is the necessity for full grids and closer, more exciting racing. The ARDC are happy to consider a 5 lap and 8 lap race at each meeting. There is also the possibility of a shorter race for non qualifiers if necessary.

Bathurst in October is still not a certainty. Appendix J will need to put up a good show in the first few meetings of the year to maximise our chances.

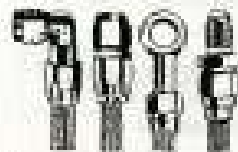

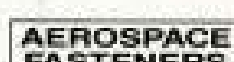

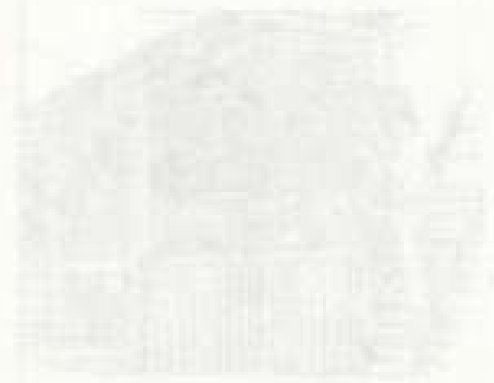
